

Dear Students and Parents,

Because the Grade 6 Summer CCD Program focuses so much on Holy Scripture, each class member will be keeping a scripture scroll. Please make it ahead of time, and bring to the **first class**. Directions and a diagram are listed below.

Materials empty paper towel cardboard tube
 large brown paper bag or mailing paper
 stapler
 scissors
 ruler
 12 inch piece of yarn, ribbon, or twine to tie scroll closed

1. Cut the brown paper bag to a size of 11 inches by 30 inches or a bit longer if possible.
2. Wrap the paper once around the cardboard tube and staple at each end.
3. Hold the paper lengthwise. Use a ruler to draw 9 two-inch-long lines across the top about three inches down from the edge. Leave about a one-inch space between them. Then repeat this along the bottom, so that the spaces at the top match up with the spaces below.
4. Cut on the drawn lines to make slits.
5. Tie it closed with yarn, ribbon or twine.

During each day's class students will be given strips of colored paper on which they will record verses from the Bible. On the back of these strips, they write their reflections on the verses. Scrolls will stay in the classroom during the two weeks of the July session and brought home on the last day of summer classes.
